- Soil Solutions was contracted to investigate the soil beneath an underground residential heating oil storage tank at the above address.
- On August 15, 2019, a 500-gallon underground heating oil tank was located on the north side
 of the house. The tank was laying in a north-south orientation with the top of the tank
 approximately 1.1 feet below the ground surface and the bottom of the tank approximately
 4.9 feet below the ground surface.
- Soil Solutions collected two samples from the tank in accordance with OAR-340-177. The samples were collected from the north and south ends of the tank at 4.9 to 6.9 feet below the ground surface.
- These samples were submitted to Friedman and Bruya Laboratory in Seattle, Washington to be analyzed for the NWTPH-Dx test. A copy of the laboratory report is attached, and the results are summarized below.
